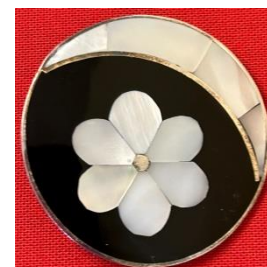

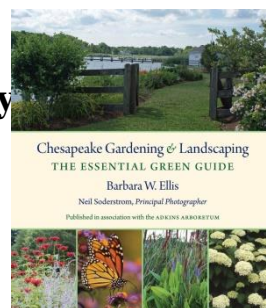
- 318 Two Crate and Barrel brand flower pots. Measure 7” height x 8.25 diameter. Donated by Nancy Holland

- 405** AMERICA'S CUP SPECIAL EDITION PRINT THOMPSON SHAMROCK III RELIANCE FRAMED, DOUBLE-MATTED, SIGNED. Reads: "Yachts of the America's Cup The big racing cutters In 1903, Shamrock III was to be Sir Thomas Lipton's third challenge for the Cup in five years. She was an unworthy antagonist for Reliance, the defender, which was the most impressive of all yachts ever to sail in the America's Cup races. She had a steel mast of 196 ft and a sail area of 16,000 sq ft., that is 2,000 sq ft more than Shamrock. Charlie Barr sailed Reliance to victory in three straight races."



- 406** Antique 19th century large (9.5 diam, 3.5 h), finely detailed cloisonne bowl. Taken to the Annual Antiques Show at Chestertown in November 2015. Todd Peenstra appraised it at \$750 retail and \$250 - \$300 at auction at that time.
